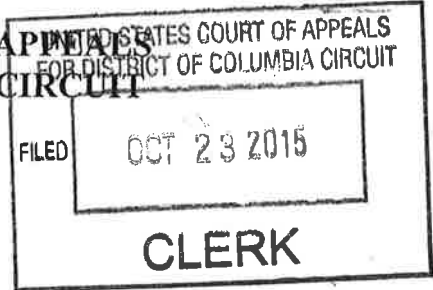

PETITION FOR REVIEW

Pursuant to section 307(b)(1) of the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7607(b)(1), and Rule 15(a) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association and the above-named member rural electric cooperatives hereby petition the Court for review of the final action of Respondent United States Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA”): “Carbon Pollution Emission Guidelines for Existing Stationary Sources: Electric Utility Generating Units,” to be codified at 40 C.F.R. Part 60, Subpart UUUU (the “Final Rule”).

The Final Rule was published in the *Federal Register* at 80 Fed. Reg. 64,662 on October 23, 2015. A copy of EPA's Final Rule is attached to this Petition.

This Petition is timely filed within sixty days of that publication as required by Clean Air Act Section 307(b)(1).

GSEC supplies its members with power from both gas-fueled turbines and wind facilities, as well as, in part, through wholesale power purchased from coal-based power plants. These sixteen member cooperatives, in turn, supply wholesale power to approximately 282,000 member-consumers located in the Texas Panhandle, South Plains and the Edward Plateau regions of Texas, the Panhandle of Oklahoma, Southwest Kansas, and Southern Colorado.

GSEC has no parent company, and no publicly held company has a 10% or greater ownership interest in GSEC.
